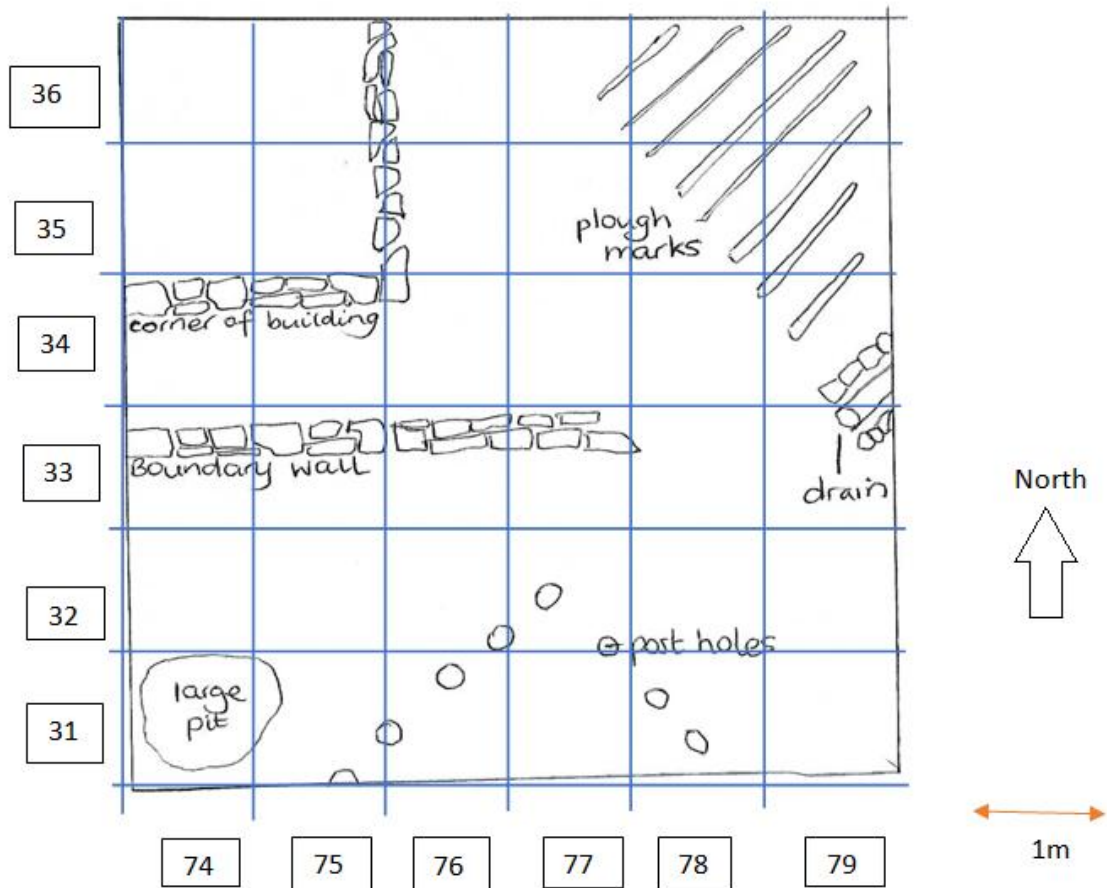


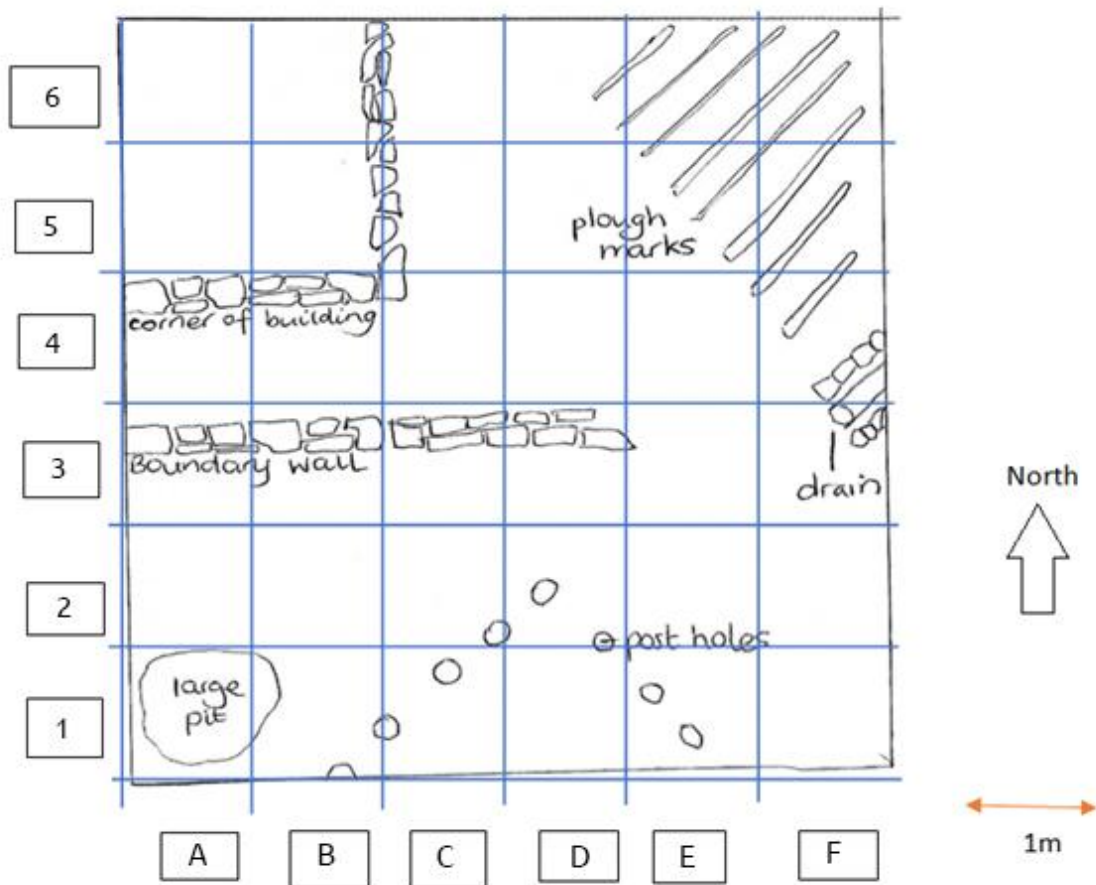
## TOPIC 6: RECORDING, GRID REFERENCES

\* A post-hole is a hole which once held a timber post. If the post burnt down the hole can be filled with charcoal. If it rotted away or as removed the hole would be filled with a different coloured soil than that around it. That is why archaeologists can spot post-holes.
